## **APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY POLICE PERMIT**

Under the Firearms (Guernsey) Law 1998, section 16(1) a person not ordinarily resident in the controlled area may apply to the Chief Officer of Police for a visitor's temporary permit to allow participation in a shoot organised by an established shooting club or other specific purpose.
